 - PhD students – currently 45 with an additional 10 students starting shortly

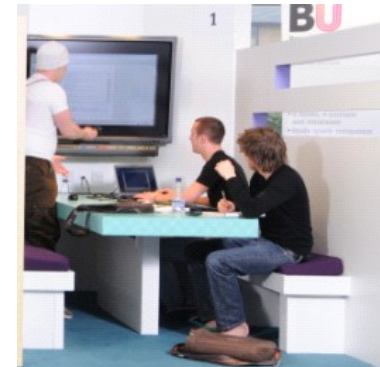
